Baseline report

Background

A mix of villages with different categories like Dalit dominated, Muslim dominated and other caste dominated villages were selected as sample for FGDs to understand the different dynamics among families of different castes and religion. Based on the Terms of Reference five villages from each of the two project districts Patna and Vaishali were selected based on three key criteria. 1. Domination of key constituencies, 2. Distance from Block HQ and 3. Intensity of rapport in the villages. There are no DNTs in the project area therefore the two key constituencies of Dalit and Muslims were taken into cognizance while undertaking the baseline study.

Section-1: Atrocities

Since the project is in its initial phase the confidence building measures are in process therefore it was difficult to make the people speak out their feelings towards the atrocities faced by them. However, attempts were made to dig out some information about the relationships. Instances shared during the FGD are enumerated below.

Village Deshrajpur, in Vaishali district is a village dominated by General Caste and OBCs. The OBCs hold the majority of agriculture land and the Dalit communities largely work as labourers either in OBC Family's agriculture land or elsewhere. Besides, there are also some Rajput caste families who feel that they are superior from the Dalit families and do not like to mix with them. There are no major issues of conflict however some minor issue do crop up time to time. Worship in the local Kali Mandir is one such issue. Although there was no evident move on the part of the Rajputs but it was felt by the Dalit community that they are not encouraged visiting this Mandir. Nevertheless they have to go little far for worship but they decided to construct a Mandir of their own. This Mandir in want of resources is not yet complete but Dalit are happy in their own Mandir.

In village Naya Gaon, district Vaishali the Dalit families are though bigger in terms of number of families but are locate4d at the outskirts of the main village. The road side area is owned by the Brahmin caste families. As such there is no conflict tin the village but last year a social tension erupted when marriage of a Dalit Girl was solemnized. The Barat was to come to the bride's house from the side of Brahmin's houses

and when the barat arrived near their house the youth from Brahmin caste instructed the barat party to play the band in front of their house so that they can dance and enjoy, which was opposed by the Dalit youth. The youth from Brahmin caste took it to their ego and some fighting did take place. The matter then looked into by the reputed persons from both the sides and was settled amicably wherein the Brahmin families apologized and assured that no such incidence will happen in the future.

Kathaulia village of Vaishali consists of mixed population but has a significant population of Dalit families. During FGD the women informed that the Anganwadi Worker comes from OBC caste and do not like the children from Dalit community. She does not like even to touch them. It was informed that the eatables in the centre are dropped in the dish of the children so that the hand or dish do not get contact. The community feels this act of untouchability but it is done in such subtle manner that notable to prove it.

Tajnagar, one of the wards of Nousha Gram Panchayat in Patna District is dominated by Muslim community whereas the adjoining wards are inhabited by Hindu families. There are few elements on both sides that are at the loggerheads and this normally surfaces during festivals. The youth of Hindu families generally take out the processions during emersions of idols after the puja in which they play music and keep dancing along with the procession. It has been observed that whenever the procession passes in front of Masjid they stop there for longer time in order to tease the Muslim youth.

The Ward Member, who is lady from Muslim community said that we have to keep a strict vigil that there is no aggression in Muslim youth against the procession, which can disturb the social harmony. She mentioned that a year ago there was an incident of murder of a Muslim boy by some criminals of Hindu community. The matter was investigated by the local police. The suspected culprits were arrested and later got bail from the court.

Village Kharjamma is in Vaishali District in which there is a separate hamlet for Dalit community. During FGD women informed that the dealer of Public Distribution System (PDS) who comes from General caste behaves very badly with the Dalit community members. He does not attend to them promptly and keeps them waiting till all the other customers are cleared. In fear of not getting ration they do not complain and bound to face his behavior.

In another FGD the men mentioned about similar behaviour in the Community Health Centre of Mahnar. The staff particularly behaves rudely with them. Even in the Sanskrit Vidyalaya, which government aided school the Dalit children are discouraged to take admission in the school.

Nehura village has sizeable population of Muslim families but are surrounded by Hindu families. The Muslim communities say that there is no conflict among them in however, in last Lakshmi puja there was a tussle during immersion of idol. Villagers did not want to reveal the problem in detail. They simply mentioned that the youth from both communities had a fighting over some non issue. The villagers said that some youth from Hindu community were drunk and created some ugly scenes, which was settled with mediators from both communities. The covering up attitude of the villagers reveals that there are rift between the communities which they do not want to share in fear of being victimised.

In village Bagsaid Khan of Vaishali district there was an incident with a boy of Dalit community. The Dalit boy was beaten up by a boy of general caste. The case went to the police but the boy from General caste was son of the local Choukidar so it was settled in the police station. Someone said that the Choukidar had to pay a bribe of Rs 1000 to settle the matter. The Dalit families did not take the matter further.

The Ward Member of Dalit tola of **Zahidpur village in Phulwarisharif** is the ex-officio President of School Management Committee (SMC). Sooner he took over the charge of SMC tried to check the malpractices in the school management. He tried to streamline the SMC meetings, Midday Meal arrangements and other development work of the school, but this did not go well with the Head Teacher of the school who comes from a General Caste. He started creating obstacles in the way. The Ward Member did not get support from his fellow community people but still he continued his good work. Later the Chief Minister of Bihar Sri Nitish Kumar visited the area during his Yatra. The Ward member openly shared with him the problem in his school. The CM ordered an enquiry and the Head Teacher was suspended for some time but nothing happened after that. He was reinstated later. The Ward member got frustrated and distanced himself from the school management.

During FGD with Muslim women in **Nayagaon village of Vaishali** it was revealed that a Muslim woman not appointed to cook Midday Meal in the local school. The authorities said that if Muslim women will cook meal the non Muslim children may not be willing to eat the meal. Hence, in order to avoid any unrest she was asked to withdraw her candidature. The Muslim community got offended but did not want to pursue this matter because they feel that this will only create rift between the communities will not help in getting any solution.

Prevention of Atrocities (POA)

None of the Dalit community members in any sample village mentioned that they know about Prevention of Atrocity Act. Even the Ward members in these villages were unaware about such an act. Therefore there was no question to ask about the provisions and procedures.

Role of Police

While discussion none of the members said that they do not fear from Police. The women members said that if do not do any wrong why should we get afraid be it police or anybody for that matter. However, when asked about their keeping distance from any case of atrocity they said that they do not want to get into any problem. Therefore it was obvious that people fear from police and court cases.

Although this was not only with Dalit and Muslim community members but even the other caste people also try to keep distance from police. A general perception found during the discussion the police takes the side of the people who are more resourceful either by money or power of political connections.

It was also found that the women groups particularly of Dalit are quite vocal and strong. They have the confidence of fighting for their cause.

None of the members said that they have visited any police station but when asked about the experience of other they said that the behavior in Police Station is not good. They talk rudely and try to dominate the person who come with any complain. At the first instance, they try to avoid taking complain and try to intimidate the person with complain to withdraw the same. This happens mainly with the poor from any community. It was said that this can even happen when the Police officer is from a Dalit community.

The community denied of any discrimination or untouchability takes place with the Dalit or Muslim community members in the police station or custody.

Perception of Muslim Communities

Altogether nine FGDs were conducted with Muslim communities during the study. In general the community members were found to be reluctant to share their feelings and most of the groups said that there is harmony in the village and there are no issues of discrimination neither in the behavior nor in the allocation of resources. However, in one location of Phulwarisharif of Patna District mentioned that there are total seven wards in their Gram Panchayat out of which two wards are Muslim dominated. It has been observed that in last 3 years since when the Mukhiya is a non Muslim (Hindu) their ward is overlooked and does not come in priority whenever any new scheme comes.

Another Ward Member who is Muslim lady said that we have to be over vigilant to ensure that no untoward incident take place because some anti social elements always look out for any such incident that can be used to create communal tension. This is more during the religious functions of both the communities. But fortunately these elements do not get support from the government authorities or even police department.

Overall they said that except some few cases here and there the environment is not fearful. We are free to celebrate our religious functions as we wish.

Sexual harassment

During the FGD no incidence of sexual harassment was shared. This is because of two key reasons, firstly such harassments are so subtle that there are no evidence of it which makes it difficult for a woman to share those, secondly, as mentioned earlier the rapport of the local partner organization is not so intimate that women have confidence of sharing their personal experiences.

It was also found that even though they are not aware of laws of the land related to atrocities there are some vocal women groups among dalit communities, who are bold enough to face and deal with any act of sexual harassment.

Section-2: Basic Public Services and Gender related

During the baseline study it was found that because of structural arrangements like located in the periphery of the village, more no of houses in less space, narrow lanes between the houses, no thatched houses, no ownership on the homestead etc. the Dalit and Muslim communities despite tall claims by the governments are devoid of basic public services.

None of the Dalit and Muslim respondents were able recall any specific development schemes of the Central or State Governments. The disappointment from the system is such that they are not interested to know about the schemes, neither there is any system to disseminate or update the reference communities about such schemes.

Among the ongoing programmes the most widespread is the ICDS programme mostly known as Anganwadi centre. Presence of these centres were found to be existing in almost all the sample villages although the numbers were not found to be adequate that can cater to all children of specified age group. This facility to an extent is availed by the children of Dalit and Muslim families only where the centres are located within their own habitation. Presently the centre is primarily providing nutrition to the enrolled children, immunization of women and children and 'Take Home Ration' to selected (6-7) pregnant and lactating women. While administering these activities except one centre no discriminative behavior with the children of Dalit and Muslim were reported.

Another extensive public service is the government schools. All the villages have at least a primary school and majority of children are enrolled in school although the attendance is not up to the mark mainly due to poor quality of education being provided there. There was no evidence of any discrimination in the class room by the school authorities. The midday meal is one area where some incidences of discrimination had come up, which is mentioned in the previous section.

The largest programme of rural wage employment, MGNREGA is almost stalled presently, the job cards had been issued widely but the employment opportunities have reduced over time. Besides, the non availability of resources in the Gram Panchayat the other key issue is the low wage rate. The potential workers get better rates than the MGNREGA work. It was also found that in some cases the work is done by the machines (JCB) or on higher wage rate and payments is withdrawn on the job cards retained by the Panchayat functionaries. The card owners are given a petty amount in lieu of using their card. This has resulted into low interest of people who actually need wage employment.

Public Distribution System (PDS) was also seen prominently in all sample villages and even the ration cards have been issued to maximum number of families. But, the cards have been issued based on the last Census data and have not been updated therefore number of persons are left out particularly the newly married youth and their children born after the Census. Apart from that the issues are irregular availability of ration, low weight, no fixed time, etc. The consumers do not complain about these issues to the higher authorities for fear of being transferred to some far off shop and also, because they have experienced that no action is being taken on the complaints. No major cases of discrimination with Dalits and Muslims have been reported except a few, which is largely related to personal behavior.

Health is another area that drains out a major share of the income of poor families that includes Dalits and Muslims. Unfortunately the state sponsored health service is in shattered condition. As mentioned in the FGDs poor families of Dalit and Muslim community prefers to go to private clinics than Government Hospitals. This is not because of any sort of discrimination but they do not have faith on the Government Health system.

Conclusion

The baseline study reveals that there are cases of discrimination on basis of caste and religion in the project villages however, it is not rampant and can be found in different pockets. In case of Dalit families the discrimination is more in the areas where the domination is of the upper castes with control over major resources like land and re close to the power centers. Among Muslims the magnitude of discrimination is relatively less and can only be seen in some areas where they do not have the numbers and access to power centers. In both the cases it is quite subtle and not visible in general observation.
