General Status of Children

Total strength of the Home is 50 children. In the reporting period, 7 children were closed but 2 children have been reopened and 5 new children have been inducted. Therefore the total number of children at present is 50.

Activities

Nutrition care

Keeping in the view the taste and preferences of children, the food menu is changed after every 3 months. The food menu is decided after discussion with the children in Balsabha.

- There are 4 children who are underweight. Their names are displayed in the kitchen. So that special care can be taken regularly. Underweight children are provided one glass of milk and an egg daily so that their health can be improved. As usual the children of food committee taking part in purchasing of vegetables and ensure that the food is prepared as per menu.

Health

- In the month of July a 10 year girl suffered from dengue, the one who was given proper treatment is fine. A child had a headache, and one child had ear pain, one 8 year girl was infected with Covid-19. Her



parents took her home. The snehsaathis continuously followed up. With proper treatment and medicines, she recovered very soon.



- Age wise all children were given corona vaccine.
- In the month of October, 5 doctors came from Indira Gandhi Medical Sciences for the eye check-up of the children

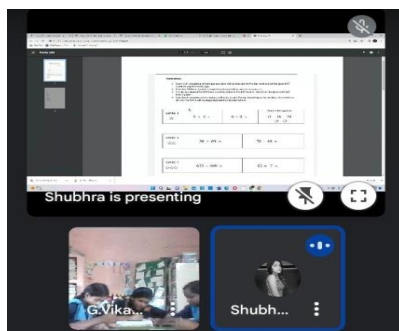
by Dr Gyan Bhaskar. 4 children have been asked for regular follow up.

- In the month of July Dr. Sadananda came home to do blood test of children.



Education

- Bridge course- There are 12 children in bridge course and 3 new children has joined in bridge course named Julie, Nisha, Jyoti, Rani, Rupa, Radha, Anshu, Priyanka Muskan, Anjali, Lalsa, Preity They are being provided regular teaching support in the home. Rest of the children will be provided coaching.
- There are some other like agencies like Bhoomi, who is providing online classes to the children of class VI to IX for Maths and English weekly 2 days. Bhumi NGO also providing online classes for class VI to VIII weekly two days for Computer.
- Shailesh Sir teaches English to the children of class 10th & 11th through online These children also go for coaching.
- 8 children completed 6-month (D.C.A) computer course.



Life Skills

- In constantly changing environment, having life skill is an essential part of being able to meet the challenges everyday. During these 6 months 18 life skill session has been taken by the team members with two groups

Life skills session were taken on these following topics-

- self confidence, self awareness, art of appreciation, me- my friend, when I am sixteen and value mall. Benefits for the individuals, in everyday life the development of life skills helps this students. Children are finding new way of thinking and problem solving ,recognizing the impact of their action, being responsible, building confidence both in spoken skills and group collaboration and make decisions. Developing a greater sense of self awareness appreciation for others.



Extra-Curricular Activities

Future Program

Every Saturday children do future meeting. They have made Life Plan for their future, Life plan shared with their parents. A summer camp was organized by Sneh Saathi. Children along with the home team decorated the home with ribbons and balloons. Summer camp was Inaugurated by Rajshekhar ji, Pinky ji Karate's trainer Amit Sir by cutting the ribbon. The camp plan was made for 15 days from 31st May. In this camp children took part in several activities like mehndi, dance, music, painting, kitchen ka kamaal. During this camp children learned various things and enjoyed a lot.



On 21 July 2022 two children from home appeared in audition test Indian Idol TV show being aired on Sony Entertainment channel .



There are 28 girls in the future Programme. Out of these 7 girls are in the age group of 18 to 23 years.

- 1 girl is studying in B.A (part-II) degree college Bengaluru.
- Two girls are studying in B.com 2nd year further they want to prepare for Banking so they are being given

coaching facilities.

- Two girls are doing hotel management course from Saathiya Bangaluru.
- 1 girl is receiving training from Sathiya, she has been approached for a job in the front office.
- 1 girl has been appointed as a volunteer at home, she is appearing in the final exam of 12th exam and is doing coaching.
- There are 9 girls of 15 years who study in class 8 & 9th
- 6 girls are of 16 years, they are studying in 10th class Additional coaching.is being provided to them .
- There are 7 girls of 17 years who study in class 11th and 12th.

Dance Program on 16th October 2022 a dance program was organized by Ninad at Boring road, Patna in which the newly trained children showed their talent.



Crafts

In this period children are doing lot of activities. Doing online classes on television, art and craft work. The children in the home being taken special care by residential team. Children doing various things like making rangoli, cards etc.





On 14 November 2022 different activities for children was organized by Bhumi in Jaipuriya school (Patna) 19 children participated in the event . In this event there were different competitions like Craft, Poster Painting, Face Painting, Rangoli, Dance, Singing, Fancy dress, etc. In these competitions 3 children got gold, in singing, 4 children got bronze, in Rangoli, 3 children got bronze in dance.

Sports and Games

Self Defense skills- karate, children practices on the regular basis in the home only with their seniors.



Karate Championship : on 11 June 15 Children Participated in Karate Championship at district level and 2 children got gold medal, 3 children Silver medal Rest of children got Bronze medal Children received medal.



Two girls from our home went to Kankarbag for an eight -day NCC camp ,where they were trained and given certificates



Community Based Centre (CBC)

Presently 25 children are covered under the CBC programme. Out of which 9 children are admitted in KGBV school in Kurji in grades 6th and 7th whereas 8 children are enrolled in KGBV Maner. Other 8 children live with their parents and study in nearby government school. These children are provided with ration, school fee, stationery, sanitary napkins and other essential items from RH every month.

Snehsaathis visit KGBV schools and meet the home children and also provide necessary item that they are not getting there like books, stationery, sanitary napkins etc.



Celebrations and Festivals

World Environment Day: World Environment Day is celebrated on the 5th June 2022 every year; it is celebrated to encourage the people on environment issues. This day is dedicated to aware about to save the resources and reconnect with the nature. As nature provide us everything to led a good and healthy life so we should protect it. A gardener had come from the garden next to the home. Whose name was Upendra Yadav, he gave a lot of information about the plants & also watered the plants with them. The children made exciting paintings and drawings which were displayed in the Home.



Yoga Diwas : The home children celebrated Yoga Diwas on 21st June 2021 On this occasion children performed different asanas of yoga with team members. The team members also explained the importance of yoga and instructed to practice yoga at regular basis as it makes our body strong and flexible and refreshes our mind. The practice of Pranayam regulates the purification of the internal system.



The home children celebrated Sawan Mahotsav on 3rd July 2022. On this occasion children performed different dance with team members. The



12 August 2022 Children of home and team members celebrated festival of Rakhi. Their brother came at home. Some children tie those Rakhi to the tree assuming it their brother. Special food was prepared for children

Independence Day: - Children of home and team members celebrated 75th Independence Day on 15th August 2022. In Middle School Dhirachak, flag hosted by Principal Sir. Children also got the



refreshments; they also gave about freedom fighters. Special food given to Children.

On 5th September 2021 Teachers Day was celebrated by the home children. altogether the children and home team members cut the cake. The children show their love by greeting all team members and telling how they take care of them. Children also told that they learn to live a better life through the home and their team members. The children celebrated it with great interest.

On 14th September home children celebrated Hindi Divas. In which they performed Poetry,



story composed by them. They played games and also got knowledge of alphabet acquired through T.L.M.

Durga Puja: On 26 September 2022 the occasion of Durga Puja Children made their own Plan. Under this plan children walk many Places. Children went for a walk eating their favorite food. From place-to-place walk Puja pandal They ate different types of delicious food. The children enjoyed a lot like this

Gandhi Jayanti Under the Star program held in Rupuspur Nahar pe. In which the home team member and children are involved. The program started by giving speech about Gandhi ji and reciting poem. Afterwards “Gandhi” drama Performed by children and. Candle March held i everyone included. Afterwards children and home team members share



their ideas and opinion about Gandhi Ji. At last children Said that we will try to move further Ghandhi’s Path.

Diwali- On 24th 2022 Team members and children celebrated Diwali. The children decorated the home and made different beautiful Gharaunda's with different materials like mud, cartons etc. for puja Children made beautiful diyas, rangoli cards. They lit Diyas all over that they lit diyas and they burst firecrackers. they explain the celebrating Diwali and share their favourite sweet dish. Special food was prepared for children.



14 November 2022: - On the occasion of children's day their member of Mahindra Finance came and celebrated children's day with the children, gifting them their dress, lockers and food items.



Birthday Celebrations

Birthday celebrations of children are organized every month in the Home by the children themselves. Children decorated the home very nicely. Prepared the stage to perform the event. Birthday children were called on the stage to cut the cake. All sang the birthday song and team members wished for their bright future. After cutting the cake children performed dance, solo song, group dance, cracked jokes and younger kids also recited poems. Special food was prepared in the home. All children performed dance in different songs like some gave solo performance and some performed in groups. All of them enjoyed a lot, they were so happy At the end of program they greeted all members for this day.

Rainbow Community Child Care Centre

The Rainbow Community based Child Care Centre has been initiated primarily to provide education opportunity to children deprived of learning, especially from underprivileged communities as well as providing homework supports, improve basic reading and writing skills of school children who struggles to cope with formal education in schools. This centre is also the important part of the overall community development since these centres are established among the communities, using resources from the communities and are functional for the members of these communities.

The first centre in Patna being implemented by Vikasaarth and supported by Rainbow Home Programme was inaugurated on 26 July 2022 in a community centre in Digha ghat of Patna. Presently it is catering to the needs of 43 children, both girls and boys of 5 to 14 years age group coming disadvantaged communities largely Mushhar and other scheduled caste.



Staff status:

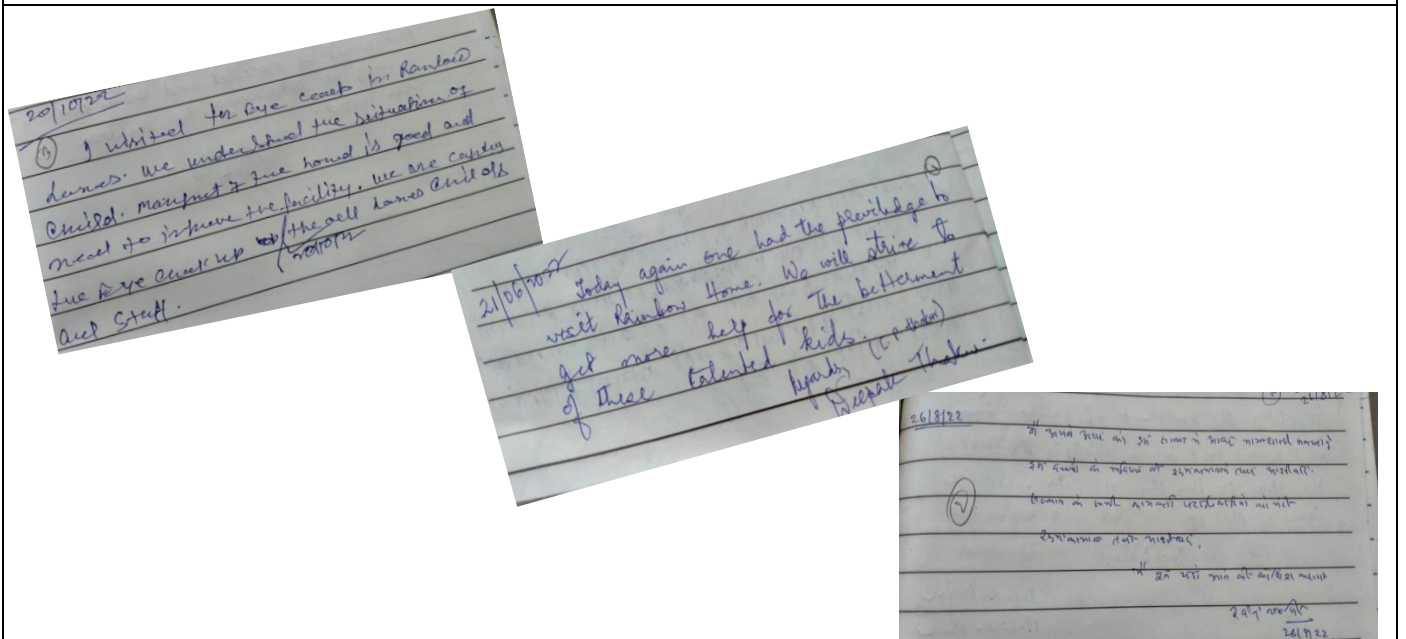
